The GALESS TiltShift Challenge (GTC) addresses an effort to contribute to awareness about complex questions in different research-domains. In 2025 the research domain is connected to "Empty Pocket". The GTC "Empty Pocket" is looking for sustainable and responsible answers from our young generation coming in from each part of the world in this particular domain. The TiltShift Challenge Empty Pocket consists of 2 conference editions in 2025 with locations in Vienna-Austria and Singapore.

The TiltShift Challenge includes a standard period for research efforts and the production of a final report followed up by physical presentations and virtual presentations. The conference will start April 22, 2025 and end on April 25, 2026. Report Presentation location: Vienna. The research activities are meant to be set in a school environment, in a school team of 3-4 students and a guiding teacher. Reference contacts from your school, local community, and region may have served as "living libraries" to support the research report as indicated in Information Pack 1/2.

What is GALESS?



3. Report Delivery & Deadlines

We ask each team to deliver their report as soon as possible now. To GALESS (info@galess.org) as well as to the project-coordinator in Vienna. Reports will be published officially on the GALESS website one week before the conference. The reports will be read by the local jury-team-panel as well as by a representation of the GALESS Jury Board.

Official comments and perspectives based on the reports and the presentation of the reports will be added to the GALESS Certificates for each and every participating team. Reports will be presented according to the agenda in the information folder. GALESS Certificates will be published and send to the teams one week after the conference.

The reports will be added to the GALESS Yearbook 2025 to be published in December 2025. Participating schools will be send a link to this book at that time.

4. Links for virtual presentations:

Please notice that the presentation times are based on local times in Vienna.

The links will be sent at the latest in the week before the conference. (Uganda, Detroit & Brazil). The presentation day for virtual presentations will be Thursday April 24, 2025 according to the agenda – timing during the day of the conference

5. Advices regarding Travelling Vienna/Europe

Travel documents:

- PASSPORT VALIDITY: Six months validity recommended, at least 3 months validity beyond your planned date of departure from the Schengen area is required.
- BLANK PASSPORT PAGES: Two pages required for entry stamp.
- TOURIST VISA REQUIRED: Not required for stays under 90 days within each 180-day period.

Weather:

Weather patterns are shifting, but April and November tend to be the wettest months, while temperatures are lowest in January and climb highest in July. May and September usually offer the most pleasant conditions.

Insurances:

Get comprehensive travel-insurance before you leave and read the fine print.

Your policy needs to cover all overseas medical costs, including medical evacuation. The Australian Government won't pay for these costs.

Connectivity:

The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Yes, you need a power plug travel adapter for sockets in Austria.

Austria uses the **Type F plug**. Type F electrical plugs used in Austria are manufactured to the CEE 7/4 and CEE 7/7 standards and is commonly referred to as a Schuko plug. The line and neutral plug contacts for Austria Type F plugs are two round pins with a 4.8 millimeter diameter.



Payment Information:

Payment Info will be sent to you directly from the organization in Vienna separately for those teams visiting the conference physically.

Media:

If schools want to upload an introduction-movie of their team on the gales-website, let us know (<u>info@gales.org</u>) Photo's from the conference will be used for public publication and publication on the GALESS website and website of the organizing school. In case of any objection, please get in contact with the local projectleader.

6. Further information / Q &A

- Food food allergies
 - Q: You are going to visit a foreign country. In this case Austria. How do I deal with any food-allergy?
 - A: Just bring any food allergy to the attention of the food-provider. Food providers are very familiar with this problem and will act-advise accordingly.
- Q: What languages are required to communicate?
 - A: European people are familiar with the English language. English language is the standard conversation language in GALESS projects

WIFI connection

Q: Does the organizing school have a WIFI connection available for visiting students

A: Yes

- Sun protection

Q: Do we need sun-protection for our visit?

A: Advisable yes!

- Lunches/dinners

Q: Are lunches – dinners included in the conference fee?

A: Lunches & dinners are included based on information in the agenda.

- Money:

Q Can I pay with my credit-card or bank-card in Austria?

A: Normal credit-cards (MASTERCARD/VISA) are accepted in Austria. For bank-cards please ask your bank before you leave. Advise: take some cash (EUROI) for small purchases

- Hospital Information:

Please consult the local project-leader about this issue at arrival for any possible emergencies.
