

2026: A Galess Master Plan for "Colours Included" under construction




After new conferences in the domain Life Sources in 2024, and Empty Pocket in 2025, our last domain called "Colours Included" will be introduced **on 5 continents in five different conferences in 2026**! We have already made arrangements with 3 organizing schools in 2026. The other two schoolsconferences on the last two continents are "under construction". We'll address in "Colours Included" 5 different issues in our research assignments where the Thesis will be connected to five *sub*domains.

- Diversity, Equity & Inclusion
- Refugees
- Indigenous People
- Black Lives Matter
- Racism and women's rights

The GALESS website will be enhanced in January 2024 with the Sustainable School Concept.




Schools which have organized a GALESS activity get a life-long preference entry-ticket in the next GALESS conferences with their student-teams. Schools which have participated in GALESS conferences 2 times or more get a "preferred portal status" for conferences if they produce a GALESS Sustainable Certificate Document for their school. The guidelines for such a document will be published on January 5, 2024.

If you were a GALESS organizer or if you are part of the - preferred portal status- , the teamcertificates for your students will carry the GALESS green logo.
